All cover crops provide **ground cover, build soil health** and offer **long-term economic gains**.

OATS

An excellent quick growing feed source that helps to improve soil structure and composition, and supports mycorrhizal fungi.

RADISH

A deep-rooted radish purposed in breaking through hard sub-surfaces, increasing water permeation, forming root channels, all the while capturing excess nutrients and suppressing weeds. Leaving little residue on the soil surface, they're excellent for minimum and no-till operations.

CRIMSON CLOVER

A quick establishing legume that fixes nitrogen with manageable residue.

FORAGE PEAS

Provides a great protein boost when added to cereal mixes. Aids in increasing organic matter and fixing nitrogen.

FALL RYE

Fibrous root system helps reduce erosion by holding soil in place over winter and early spring. Can be used as additional feed source and provides excellent weed suppression.

SORGHUM

A warm season grass with quick establishment that suppresses weeds while offering excellent forage and grazing options.
