#### **New Lawns**

- Plant your grass seed when soil temperatures are between 10 to 18°C.
- Prep the area before planting grass seed by removing dead grass and loosening hard soil.
- Seed to soil contact is necessary for germination.
- Watering new seedlings is crucial until they are established.
  - Do not let seeded area dry out
  - Avoid puddles
  - Water in the morning
- Use our Turf Starter Fertilizer to promote germination and root development with seeding.

#### **V** SS TURF TIP

For best results, overseed your new lawn for one full growing season to promote a thicker lawn to prevent weeds.

### **Y** SS TURF TIP

The best storage of grass seed is in a sealed container in a cool, dry place.

Overseed every spring and fall to promote a thick, lush lawn.

| Hard Fescue         | 14-21                | Good                | Very Good         | Low   |

# **Y** SS TURF TIP

Avoid too little or too much seed when planting as seedlings need enough space to access water and nutrients.

#### **Fertilizer**

Fertilizer and seed can be applied separately or at the same time. When applying fertilizer and seed at the same time, spread the fertilizer first and then the seed to avoid less foot/wheel traffic to the seed. Best to apply fertilizer with rain or ensure you water in all of your fertilizer.
